



Lucky Iron Fish

In Cambodia, and especially across the remote Koh Rong archipelago, iron deficiency is a large concern, causing decreased energy, strength, and alertness.

To combat this ailment The Song Saa Foundation has partnered with Lucky Iron Fish to substantially reduce instances of iron deficiency anemia.

Project

Coinciding with educational workshops on nutritional health and naturally present iron in food, The Song Saa Foundation will distribute Iron Fish to the people of the Koh Rong archipelago to improve the health and wellbeing of the overall population.

Objective

Distribution of 550 Iron Fish to the most needing families in the Koh Rong archipelago partnered with 12 educational workshops on the importance of iron in a person's daily diet. We will also host a 3 day visit of the Iron Fish team to Koh Rong for education work shops and Iron Fish distribution.

Impact

- Improve the health and wellbeing of communities in the archipelago
- Raise awareness of the importance of an iron rich diet.
- Nurture a sustainable partnership with Lucky Iron Fish to ensure long term provision of iron fortification to the region.



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
